# Examples of projects we have already helped with

Strettons Mayfair Trust, Church Stretton. Grant for £2,000 given towards the cost of their kitchen refurbishment. Amongst other services that this kitchen provides is all year round meals out to the elderly in the community and thus aligned with the trust's objectives.

Yew Tree Court, Shifnal. Grant of £654 towards the provision of a greenhouse to enable the elderly residents to make full use of the garden at the Home.

Priory Hall Much Wenlock. Grant of £3,621 towards complete refurbishment of the disabled toilets at the Hall for the benefit, primarily, of the elderly in the Town.

Individual application at Randlay, Telford. Grant of £1,288 given towards the cost of providing a wet room for a disabled man in his own home.



Ambulance Car Campaign for Much Wenlock Community First Responders. Grant of £3,000 towards the purchase of a 4x4 vehicle to enable a First Responder unit to be set up in Much Wenlock
